

I walk home (and/or to school) and the traffic around here is hectic.

No matter what direction you come from, or want to go to, there are potential problems and dangers around this campus. Here are some suggestions when walking:

- Before and after school there is a policeman aiding pedestrians crossing 55th and Grant Streets. This is the best place to cross 55th Street.
- Do not cross 55th Street between Madison and Grant.
- When you cross 55th Street at Madison, pay close attention to the light and cross only when the walk light is displayed.
- Be careful crossing Grant at 57th Street. Watch for the cars stopping at the stop signs.
- Only cross Grant Street at the designated crosswalks. Walking across Grant anytime is dangerous due to limited visibility.
- Crossing Madison and going to 56th Street is dangerous. Cross Madison with the light at the corner of 55th
- Only walk on sidewalks, not in the streets.

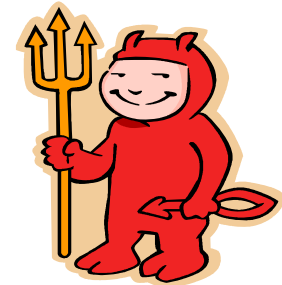
Where can I be picked up after school (or dropped off before) that is safe?

- Pick-up/drop off at the pool drop-off area or pick-up zone on Grant Street.
- Pick up students at a safe alternative location off campus.
- Use the bus lane in front of the school anytime except for the 2:00 p.m. - 3:20 p.m. bus only time.
- Do not pick up/drop off on 55th Street.

Other safety tips:

- Tell your parents to come for you after 3:20. The busses have left the campus by that time and congestion is minimal.
- **Right turn** only onto Grant St. out of the auditorium/student lot exit between 7a.m.-8:30 a.m. and 2 p.m.-3:30 p.m.
- **Right turn** only onto Grant St. out of the loading dock/pool entrance on Grant Street
- **Right turn** only onto Grant St. out of the circle drive in front of the school.
- There are **NO** U-turns permitted on Grant Street at all. Remind your parents. Signs are posted.
- There is no pick-up/drop off on Grant Street from 55th Street to the posted sign designating pick-up area. You can/will be ticketed.
- There is a law that when busses are loading or unloading they must put out their stop signs. Failure to stop in either direction, if you are a driver, is a fine of up to \$500 and 3 month loss of license.
